



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **Do you have to purchase a unit?**

No. There is a nominal one-time administration fee paid prior to entry and regular monthly fees to follow. There are no property taxes and town/city utilities to worry about. In fact, it is a yearly tax deduction.

### **How do you hold an apartment?**

Provide a deposit of \$1000 with a completed reservation application.

### **Is the deposit refundable?**

Yes if you change your mind or your path has changed prior to moving in the deposit will be refunded.

### **Can I bring my own furniture?**

Yes. Apartments are provided unfurnished. Thirwood Place will provide the appliances (refrigerator, dishwasher, stove, washer and dryer). You just bring everything that reminds you of home.

**May I have guests in for meals?**

Thirwood Place offers complimentary meals for guests based on the resident's meal plan.

**May I have overnight guests?**

Guests may stay in your apartment. Thirwood Place offers cots for that extra visitor. Residents' guests can also stay in one of our hotel-style guest suites for a nightly rate.

**May I bring a pet?**

Dogs and cats are welcome to live at Thirwood Place. Pets must be properly cared for.

**Is transportation always available?**

The Cove offers transportation to medical appointments within a 10 mile radius on a rotating schedule. There are also weekly trips to local supermarkets and pharmacies. Once a week, there is also a bus that travels the "loop" to handle your other shopping and service needs. There is also transportation to some local places of worship. Special trips are also made regularly to excursions and local destinations.
